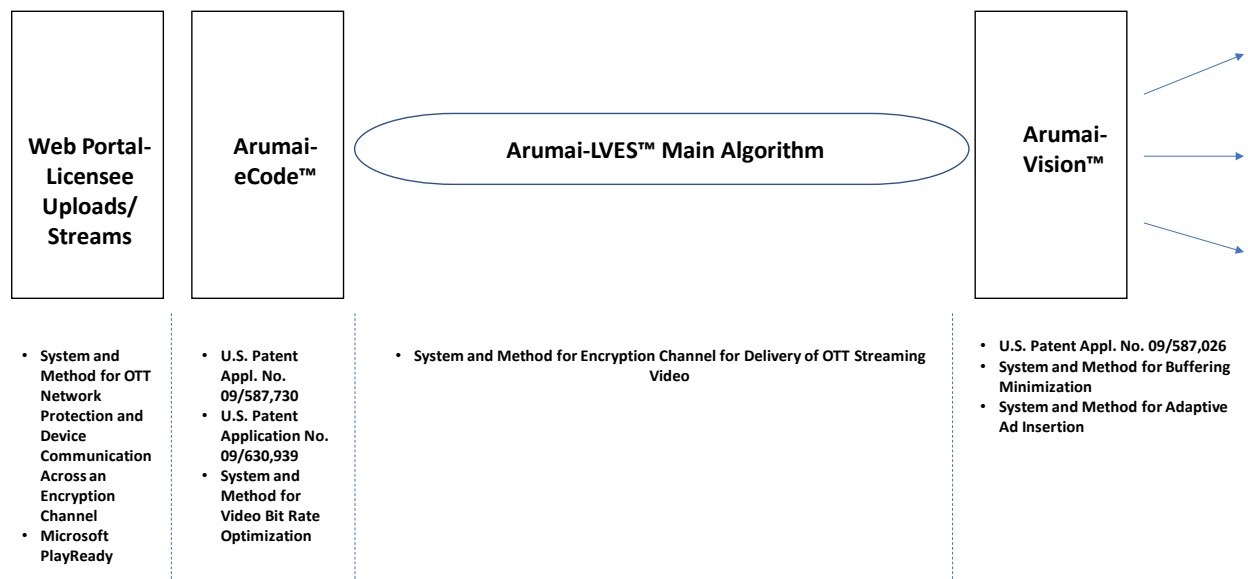
### Arumai CEO, P. Stephen Lamont, Discharged from Regional Medical Center in San Jose, CA.
